MCH-II

Mother and Child health care building is a four storeyed fully air-conditioned. Each floor is divided in A and B block.

Ground floor: MCH OT. There are 3 operation theatres running 24*7 for emergency obstetric cases.

A dedicated team of doctors and nurses takes care of the patients.

1st and 3rd floor: Both floors cater to a diverse range of women's health needs with 70 beds on 1st floor and 58 beds on 3rd floor. Wards are systematically divided into different compartments for gynaecology patients, obstetric cases, post-operative patients, postnatal mothers, and septic patients. separate room for breastfeeding and medicolegal cases, ensuring specialized and focused care.

The wards are staffed by a dedicated team of doctors and nurses, providing round-the-clock service.

Kangaroo mother care on 3rd floor is one of the largest unit of the state taking care of preterm and low birth weight neonates.

2nd floor : Neonatal Intensive Care Unit which provides tertiary level care to the sick newborn babies. The department is well equipped with all tertiary level care instruments.

With high patient turnover and comprehensive services, MCH plays a pivotal role in the hospital's commitment to maternal, neonatal and reproductive health.

Labor Room:-

Our state-of-the-art, fully air-conditioned labour room complex is designed to provide comprehensive, round-the-clock care for expectant mothers and newborns offering a wide range of specialized rooms and services to ensure safety, comfort, and high standards of medical care in both routine and emergency situations.

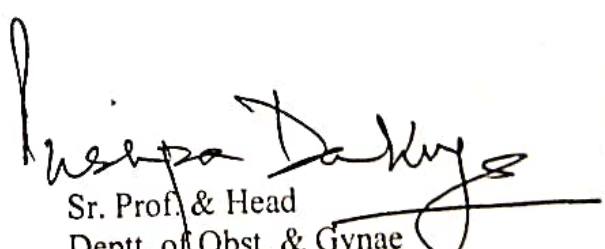
Key Facilities Include:

 - Labour-Delivery-Recovery (LDR) Rooms – including LDR 2 and LDR 3
 - Post-Natal Delivery Rooms

MCH OT:-

MCH OT works round the clock catering of both elective and emergency cases, including cesarean sections, hysterectomies, and other gynecological procedures. The presence of a separate septic OT allows for safe management of infected or high-risk cases without compromising the sterility of clean surgeries. Regular sterilization practices, strict adherence to aseptic techniques, and continuous monitoring ensure a safe surgical environment. The high daily surgical volume reflects both the trust patients place in the institution and the efficiency of the surgical team. The unit also plays a key role in training postgraduate students and interns in operative obstetrics and gynecology.
