 - The consultant on a particular operation table is fully responsible for all the cases on 3. his table e.g their surgery, postponement etc.

 - 1. Staff Nurses are fully responsible for nursing care to patients and maintenance of

 - Class-IV employees assist the officers in above mentioned work of the deptt.
 - 4. House surgeons are fully responsible for total patient care alongwith completing and depositing the records of patients.
- The decision regarding treatment of patient in OPD is done by consultant/house surgeon (111) whosoever has seen the patient.
 - 1. The decision regarding admission of the patient is taken by Head of the Department in consultation with consultants of the Department.
